- Protective helmet with face guard • Metal bat with barrel size not to ex
  - Metal bat with barrel size not to exceed 2.25"; bats inscribed with the phrase "Official Tee-Ball" are permitted
  - Cleats are recommended but not required. Players may only wear cleats with plastic or rubber cleats. No metal spikes allowed.
  - It is recommended that all male players wear protective cups, whether in the field or at bat
- **JUNIOR** Protective helmet with face guard • Metal bat with barrel size not to ex
  - Metal bat with barrel size not to exceed 2.25", or metal bat up to 2.625" barrel so long as the bat has a "USA Baseball" stamp; bats inscribed with the phrase "Official Tee-Ball" are permitted. Wooden bats also permitted.
    - Cleats are recommended but not required. Players may only wear cleats with plastic or rubber cleats. No metal spikes allowed.
    - It is recommended that all male players wear protective cups, whether in the field or at bat
  - Protective helmet with face guard
  - Metal bat with barrel size not to exceed 2.25", or metal bat up to 2.625" barrel so long as the bat has a "USA Baseball" stamp; bats inscribed with the phrase "Official Tee-Ball" are permitted. Wooden bats also permitted.
  - Cleats are recommended but not required. Players may only wear cleats with plastic or rubber cleats. No metal spikes allowed.

- Protective helmet with face guard, or protective helmet with C-flaps and a permanently affixed NOCSAE stamp (C-flap helmets with this stamp are not permitted)
- Wooden bat (composite wooden bats acceptable) or bat with certified 0.50 Batted Ball Coefficient of Restitution ("BBCOR")
- Cleats are recommended but not required. Players may only wear cleats with plastic or rubber cleats. No metal spikes allowed.
- It is recommended that all male players wear protective cups, whether in the field or at bat
- LIBERTY
- Protective helmet (face guards and C-flaps optional)
- Wooden bat (composite wooden bats acceptable) or bat with certified 0.50 Batted Ball Coefficient of Restitution ("BBCOR")
- Metal spikes permitted
- It is recommended that all male players wear protective cups, whether in the field or at bat
